The Pastor's Perspective Dr. Reggie Bridges

Our **Junior High students**, **grades 6-8**, now meet on Wednesday nights at 6 p.m. in the Youth Room for worship. We've seen so many junior high students!! Maybe they feel less intimidated, maybe they like the format and games being specifically geared for younger teenagers, maybe they love being led in worship by their own junior high worship band, or maybe it's something else. But they are coming to worship together in big numbers! Every week is exciting and usually brings new faces to see what God is doing.

Our **High School Worship** happens on Sunday nights at 6 p.m. in the Youth Room. This was a significant adjustment for many of our older students, but they are also coming and experiencing God through worship services that are designed just for them. We can talk about topics and issues that apply to them specifically rather than junior high students. They have been able to talk with each other about how Scripture applies to their lives and pray for one another. This group has also grown, and we're seeing new faces come almost every week.

These two worship services seem to be increasingly different each week while more effectively reaching each group with God's Word. Pray for our students and our Youth Ministry as we continue to adapt and find ways to help students encounter God.
