I want to briefly share the lyrics of a new song we sang in *the gathering* yesterday. The title of the song is "Christ Be Magnified." The chorus goes like this:

"Christ be magnified, let His praise arise / Christ be magnified, in me Christ be magnified, from the altar of my life / Christ be magnified, in me"

These are simple, yet beautiful lyrics that should serve as a prayer for our lives. So, what does it mean for Jesus Christ to be magnified in us? Like me, I'm sure many of you can get caught in the trap of being consumed by the daily toils of life. Medical issues, financial struggles, and family problems can occupy our minds to a point that we forget about who the Lord is and what He has done.
